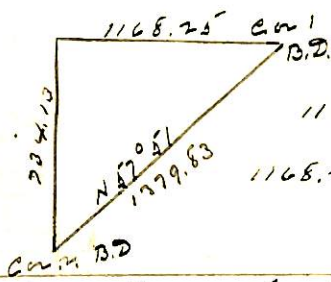
Note
