All Definitions, Theorem, and Problems: with Plain Trigonometry and Whotever else is useful in the Theory of Surveying. Part III. The Description and Use of Instruments necessary in the Practice of Surveying. PartIV. How to Measure, Cast up, Plot, and Divide Parcels of Land. Appendix. Concerning Levelling and Conveying of Water to any possible place assign'd. William Hume's 1740s works include not only the well known GEODOESIA ACCURATA: OR, SURVEYING MADE EASY BY THE CHAIN ONLY, but also A NEW ESSAY UPON SOLIDS. This 5 1/4" by 8 1/8" by 1 7/8" book contains TEN FOLDING PLATES. The books cornors are slightly bumped and both the front and back hinges show signs of cracking. Overall, the binding is very tight.
